2018 Alumni Survey	The alumni survey was sent to all PhD, DBA, and IMBA students who graduated between during the academic year and each of the four preceding years. Alumni were invited to participate in the survey through an email campaign and were asked to complete an anonymous online form. All questions were multiple choice with an extra section for open qualitative feedback. Response rates per program were as follows: 20% for IMBA, 33% for DBA, and 28% for PhD.
